This was revealed by Dr DK Giri, Dean, Faculty of Education, while inaugurating a workshop on "How to write objectives in

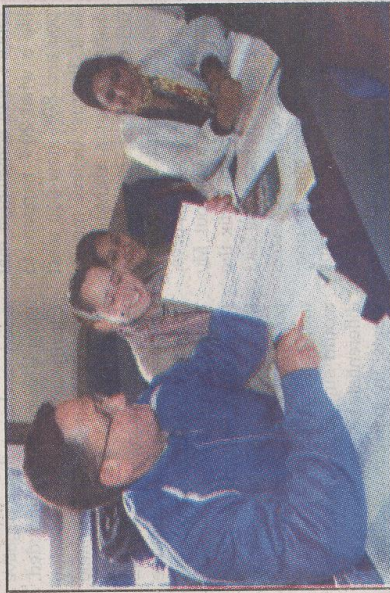
subjects like Mathematics, Life Sciences, Geography, Social Studies, Commerce, Accountancy and Environmental Science.

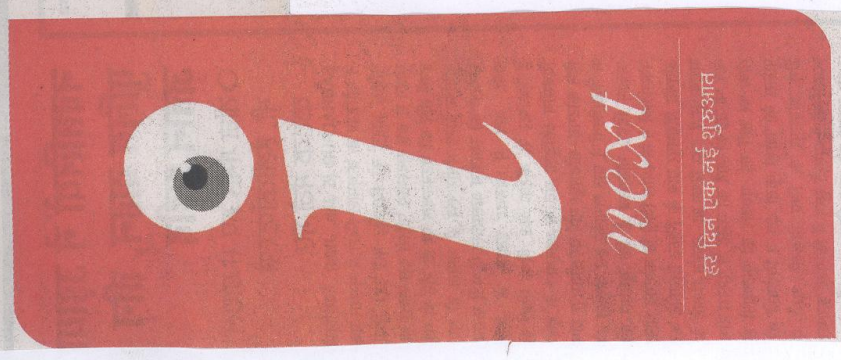
